In Credit 4 of Indoor Environmental Quality, it addresses the VOC content of adhesives and sealants, paints and coatings, flooring system and composite wood and agri-fiber products. **STYROFOAM XPS and THERMAX™ insulation products are not explicitly addressed in this section and do not impact this LEED credit.**
